Mayor Fox presented and placed for passage an ordinance O2024-017 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS SET FORTH IN THE SEVIERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 14-201 TO REZONE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 120 E MAIN ST FROM INTERMEDIATE COMMERCIAL (IC) DISTRICT TO TOWN CENTER (TC) DISTRICT." A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Alderman McCroskey to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Helton, McCroskey, Ohman, Rader. Those voting No: None. Those abstaining: Koester. Fox declared the ordinance passed on third and final reading.

Mayor Fox presented and placed for passage an ordinance O2024-018 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS SET FORTH IN THE SEVIERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 14-201 TO REZONE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 139 SMOKY MOUNTAIN WAY, FROM ARTERIAL COMMERCIAL (AC) DISTRICT TO HIGH DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (HDR) DISTRICT." A motion was made by Vice Mayor Koester and seconded by Alderman Rader to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Helton, Koester, McCroskey, Ohman, Rader. Those voting No: None. Fox declared the ordinance passed on third and final reading.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Fox recognized Russell Treadway, who presented and placed for passage a Resolution R2024-012 Authorizing the City of Sevierville to Donate \$125,000 to Mountain Ways to Assist with Relief and Recovery Efforts from Hurricane Helene. Treadway stated that the funds would be earmarked for relief in East Tennessee counties. A motion was made by Alderman Rader and seconded by Alderman Ohman to approve the resolution as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Matt Henderson, who presented bids for a water tanker/tender and recommended approval of the sole qualified bid and award of contract to Safe Industries in the amount of \$616,800.00. Henderson further requested approval of the truck and equipment totaling the budgeted amount of \$665,000.00. A motion was made by Alderman Rader and seconded by Alderman McCroskey to approve the requests as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Bob Parker, who presented bids for golf course chemicals and recommended approval of the low qualified bid and purchase from Harrell's in the amount of \$137,927.75. A motion was made by Vice Mayor Koester and seconded by Alderman Helton to approve the purchase as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Joe Manning, who requested approval to purchase seven desks for patrol lieutenants from OfficeWorks in the amount of \$12,017.00 under Omnia Partners contract #2020000610. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Alderman Ohman to approve the purchase as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Joseph Manning, who requested approval to purchase eight in-car video cameras/subscriptions for police pursuit vehicles from sole source Vu-Link vendor Digital Ally in the total amount of \$113,400.00, payable over five years due to the maintenance and storage subscription components. A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Vice Mayor Koester to approve the purchase as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Keith Malone, who presented bids for the Gateway 407 sewer improvements project and requested approval of a contract with Charles Blalock & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$332,000.00. Malone noted that the project will be funded by an Appalachian Regional Commission

(ARC) grant with matching contributions from Kituwah, LLC. A motion was made by Alderman Rader and seconded by Alderman Ohman to approve the contract as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Doug Tarwater, who requested approval of an incremental expenditure in the amount of \$7,652.45 with CMA Equipment Sales, Inc. for leaf collection truck duct intake equipment. Tarwater noted that the original price of the truck, approved December 18, 2023, did not include the equipment and that the total amount falls within budget. A motion was made by Vice Mayor Koester and seconded by Alderman Helton to approve the expenditure as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Fox recognized Doug Tarwater, who requested approval to purchase street survey software from sole proprietary vendor Roadway Management Technologies, LLC in the amount of \$23,900.00. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Alderman Rader to approve the purchase as presented. Motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 6:14 PM.
